
HOW TO – APPLY FOR A POLICE INFORMATION CHECK


1. Visit https://www.policesolutions.ca/checks/services/edmonton/ and select 'REGISTER' in the top right hand corner. You only need to register if it is your first time applying. Otherwise, select LOGIN.



2. Enter the registration information and click 'PROCESS MY REGISTRATION' at the bottom.

You are now ready to proceed with a police check application.

- **3.** Proceed to the landing page and select the application type you require. Please ensure you take your time and select the correct one. If you are unsure, please contact us or the agency requesting your police check.
- 4. Enter the Position/Employer information. This



- 5. Enter all your demographic information.*If you presently have a criminal record, please utilize the self-declaration portion to*
- 6. Review your personal information. Please ensure everything you have entered is correct.
- 7. Make your payment.
- **8.** Complete the ID verification. If you do not pass the verification, you will be contacted with further instruction.
- **9.** Congratulations! You have successfully submitted your police check. You will receive an email when your finished certificate is ready.

 yellow Shield 6)




